A special performance of a contemporary composition by Rolf Johnson, a musician in the NORAD Band as well as the Commander's Jazz Band, will highlight the program.

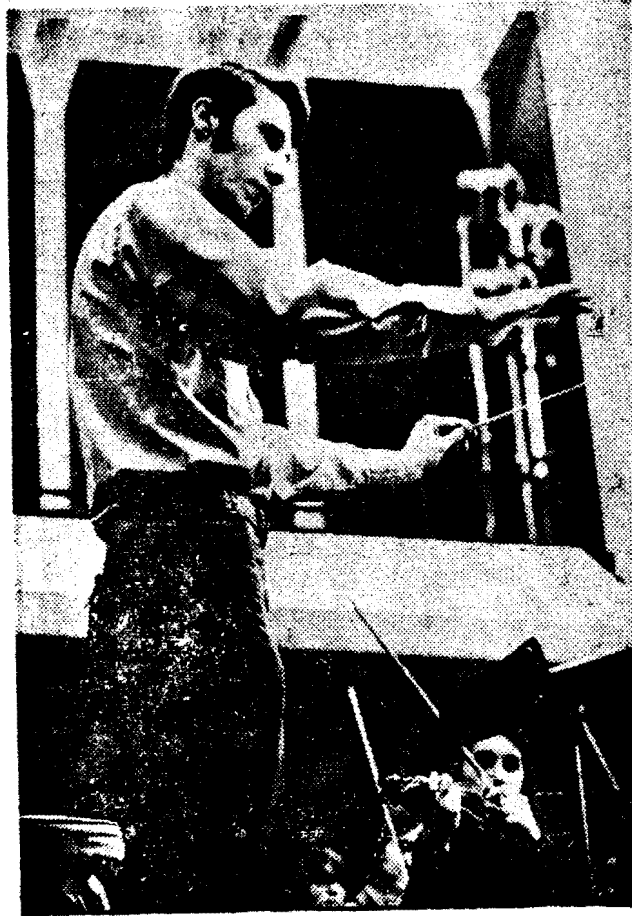
In addition the group will perform other numbers under
